



**RIURAU FILM FESTIVAL**  
**INTERNATIONAL SHORT FILM FESTIVAL**  
VIII Edition 2019

**BASES** (Please read carefully all the 12 points of these bases)

The RIURAU FILM FESTIVAL (RRFF) was created with the aim of offering a space of encounter, diffusion, development and competence to short filmmakers from all over the world. It is organized by Escola de Cinema Riurau Association (ECRR) whose members form the Festival Selection Committee, together with the teachers of l'Escola.

The VIII edition of the RRFF will take place in the Marina Alta region, Alicante (E) in the following dates and venues:

- La Xara, on Friday, August 23
- Jesús Pobre, on Friday, August 30
- Denia, on Friday, September 6 and on Saturday 7
- Xàbia / Jávea, on Friday, September 13 and Saturday 14

### **1. Participation.**

Open participation to all producers and directors of short films of any age and nationality.

Each producer or director may submit the number of works desired, **provided they have not been presented previously in this contest.**

### **2. Sections of the festival.**

The RRFF consists of the following categories or sections:

- a) LGBTI fiction
- b) Dance Film
- c) Fiction (General)
- d) Social Thematic Fiction: "Ethnic Inclusion"
- e) The Sea and its Environment (see specifications on point 5)
- f) Fiction shorts in Valenciano language (see especifications on point 6)
- f) RIURAU EXPRESS (see specifications on point 7)

The Selection Committee reserves the possibility of changing a short film to a different section, according to its theme.

### **3. Short films' production dates.**

- Any film produced as of January 1, 2017 will be eligible for the contest.
- For the Social Thematic Fiction section "Ethnic Inclusion," a production date will be accepted as of January 1, 2015.
- For the Fiction shorts in Valenciano language, a production date is not observed for this first year call.
- RIURAU EXPRESS section shorts will be produced between the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> August in Jesús Pobre.

#### 4. RRF Conditions and requirements for all short films.

**4.1. Duration of short films:** For all categories, the maximum duration will be 20 minutes, **except for the express short films**, whose duration will not exceed 5 minutes (see specifications on point 7).

**4.2. The contest does not accept documentary films**, except for short films within the section "The Sea and its Environment".

**The contest does not consider the animation** as an absolute category, although it will admit the punctual use of it as a cinematographic resource.

The presentation of any animated film or documentary outside the parameters mentioned, would entail the automatic rejection of the film by the selection committee.

**4.3. Subtitles:** All shorts that participate in any of the sections will be presented in the original version.

Short films in Spanish or Valenciano will include subtitles in English.

Short films in other languages than Spanish or Valenciano are entitled to include subtitles in any of this two co-official languages of the festival. Optionally, they can insert a second line of subtitles in English.

**4.4. Copies:** Participants will provide the organization with a copy of their short film in HQ or HD quality format to be downloaded and screened during the festival or in the projections described below:

- The RRF reserves the possibility of screening, prior to the festival, a selection of the short films. Likewise, the awarded films may be screened in a subsequent session open to the public organized by the RRF and the Escola de Cinema Riurau Association (ECRR).
- Copies of all selected films will remain in the archives of the Film Archive of the RRF, created for its conservation, consultation and as teaching material for the film school.

**4.5. Advertising material:** Participants will also send the promotional **poster** of the film and a promotional **trailer** for its use in the diffusion of the Festival.

The RRF organization reserves the possibility of using a fragment of up to 1 minute of the shorts selected, for its publication on the festival website <http://www.riuraufilmfestival.com/>

**4.6. Minors:** Any participant under the age of 18 must be represented by one of their parents or, where appropriate, the tutor, who must download, complete and send by email the Minor Authorization Form to the festival (attached at the end of these rules).

An adult representative will assume the total responsibility for the presentation of the film and the image rights of all the participating children.

**4.7. Rights:** The participant will be fully responsible for showing all the rights related to the film submitted to the contest. The Festival is not responsible for the lack of rights of image, sound, permission for minors, etc. that can compete in the short films.

**4.8 Achieving an award requires** the publication of the RRF's laurel in the credits of the short film.

#### 5. "The Sea and its Environment" Film Section.

Only in this section documentary films will be accepted, in addition to fiction short films on the theme, and with the same duration limit.

The purpose of this new section, promoted by the Oceanogràfic Foundation within the RFFF, is to value the marine environment in order to show its current problems and their consequences in our daily lives.

## 6. Short Film in Valencian language

Short films in Valencian language will include subtitles in Spanish and if possible also in English.

## 7.- RIURAU EXPRESS Section.

This specific short films will be produced in Jesús Pobre (Alicante) during the 24 and 25 August 2019.

**Registration in the RIURAU EXPRESS section** is free and will be open from the start of this call until end of Friday August 23, 2019. It will be done by sending an email through the contact page of the website [www.riuraufilmfestival.com](http://www.riuraufilmfestival.com) stating the willingness to participate in the section and adjoining the name, surname and contact (telephone and mail) of the responsible person or group.

The **theme** will be free: on Saturday, August 24, at 10 o'clock in the morning in the town hall of Jesús Pobre, **there will be mandatory guidelines** for all express short films. The requirements that each of the shorts must contain may be urban and architectural locations of Jesús Pobre, a local activity, present event, etc.

The maximum **duration** of the express short film may not exceed **5 minutes**.

**In addition**, each short film must contain: logo of the festival, title of the short film and final credits. Logo can be downloaded from the website [www.riuraufilmfestival.com](http://www.riuraufilmfestival.com)

For the making of the short film, **36 hours** (24 h + 8 h of rest) will be provided, including recording, editing and submission by **WeTransfer** platform before August 24 at 10 p.m.

The City Council of Jesus Pobre will enable a room with WIFI for those who wish to work "in situ" on the editing.

The short films selected will be screened on Friday, August 30 at the Gran Riurau de Jesús Pobre.

## 8. Submission of the short films.

Submission of the short films will be made online through the MOVIBETA platform [www.movibeta.com](http://www.movibeta.com) **before May 15, 2019** for all sections.

The RIURAU EXPRESS films submission is described in point 6 of these bases.

The RFFF does not obtain any economic benefit with the submissions of the films. The costs of registration and copy sending through the MOVIBETA platform will be satisfied by the participants.

## 9. Selection.

The short films selected for screening will be announced on the festival website <http://www.riuraufilmfestival.com/> before **July 6, 2019** for all categories.

The Selection Committee will appreciate the use of fragmentation, multi-perspectivism and good management of the ellipsis in the short films; three inherent characteristics of Escola de Cinema Riurau Association and our festival.

## 10. Awards

The participating short films will be eligible for the following prizes by category:

**Best Fiction Short Film:** Vila de Xàbia Award with a € 700 prize, diploma and statuette.\*

**Best Direction:** Ciutat de Dènia Award with € 700, diploma and statuette.\*

**Best Dance Film:** Award endowed with 400 euros, diploma and statuette.\*

**Best LGBTI Short Film:** Jesus Pobre's EATIM award of 400 euros, diploma and statuette.\*

**Best Short Fiction Social Fiction "Ethnic Inclusion":** Award endowed with € 400, diploma and statuette.\*

**Best Short Film "The Sea and its Environment":** Endowed with 300 euros, diploma and statuette.\*

**Best Local Film on "The Sea and its Environment":** € 200, diploma and statuette.\*

Established for residents in the Marina Alta region. This prize aims to motivate the participation of local agents, as well as primary and secondary education centres, students of film schools, amateurs of the audio-visual world, etc.

**Best Short Film Express:** A first prize chosen by the jury endowed with € 300, diploma and statuette.\*

**Short Film Express Baleària Award,** chosen by the public, endowed with TWO PASSAGES of the Baleària Ferries' Company and diploma.

**Best Short Film in the Valencian Language:** Diploma.

**Best Interpreter:** Diploma.

**Best Cinematographer:** Diploma.

**Best Art Director:** Diploma.

**Best Script:** Diploma.

**Best Film Edition:** Diploma.

### Short Films In Valenciano language Awards:

**Best Short Film Fiction:** EATIM La Xara prize of € 600, diploma and statuette.

**Best Direction:** diploma and statuette.

**Best Performer:** Diploma.

**Best Photography:** Diploma.

**Best Art Direction:** Diploma.

**Best Script:** Diploma.

**Best Edition:** Diploma.

- **Money prizes** will be increased by € 200 only if the director, producer or main interpreter on behalf of the film personally attends the day of the awards ceremony.
- Prizes **are not exclusive**, which means that a short film can receive more than one prize.
- The organization will provide the corresponding **diplomas and laurels** to the winners.
- **\* Money prizes of the sections marked with an asterisk \*** will be increased by € 200 only in case the director, producer or main performer representing the film personally attends the day of the awards ceremony.
- **VERY IMPORTANT:** No statuette will be sent. The statuettes will only be delivered by hand to the winners or their accredited representative on the day of the awards ceremony.

## 10. The Jury of the RRFF.

The director of the festival will designate the Jury, formed by a minimum of three film specialists who will select the winning films. The director reserves the possibility of appointing different juries for each of the contest sections.

For the Dance Film section, the jury will be formed by members of the *Centre Coreogràfic de Denia*, specialists in this film category.

For "The Sea and its Environment" film section, the jury will be formed by: a member of the Oceanogràfic Foundation, a member of the Escola de Cinema Riurau Association and a film environment specialist.

For the RIURAU EXPRESS section, the jury will consist of members of the Escola de Cinema Riurau Association, a neighbour of Jesús Pobre's EATIM and a film specialist appointed by the festival director.

The jury's decision is final.

The jury reserves the right to declare a desert prize.

The management of the RRFF will announce the identity of the jury at the time it deems appropriate and before the start of the festival, announcing its members within the media, networks and its own website.

## 11. Acceptance of the bases and Data Protection Law.

The registration implies the full acceptance of these bases, as well as the decisions of the organization, selection committee and juries. Any matter not foreseen in the bases will be resolved by the organization of the RRFF and will be unappealable.

The organization undertakes and obliges that the personal data belonging to the data file of the participants will be treated according to article 12 of the Organic Law 15/1999, of December 13, of Protection of Personal Data (LOPD) .
